Our \$2,099 test unit came with 1GB of RAM, an 80GB hard drive, a double-layer DVD burner, and an nVidia Quadro NVS 120M graphics chip with 256MB of dedicated VRAM. Somewhat chunky for a thin-and-light (5 pounds), the notebook is clad in a magnesium-alloy frame and comes with a shock-protected hard drive. Its bright 14.1-inch wide-screen display has a native resolution of 1,280x800 (WXGA).
